2025 marked a turning point for Spectrum Medical Care Center. After 28 years of extraordinary service, our founder, Dr. Thanos Vanig, retired and passed the torch to a new generation of leadership. It has been my honor to step into the role of CEO and help lead Spectrum Medical toward becoming the leading LGBTQ+ healthcare organization in the Southwest.

At a time when LGBTQ+ communities face growing challenges to healthcare access, Spectrum Medical is stepping forward with purpose. In 2025, we expanded HIV prevention and care services, advanced plans for a new healthcare campus in Central Phoenix, and took steps to open our PrideCare Rx pharmacy services.

What began as a private, grassroots response to the HIV crisis has grown into a trusted healthcare home for thousands across Arizona. Today, we continue building toward a future where LGBTQ+ communities have access to personalized, culturally responsive healthcare designed around their needs. # HIV Prevention & Care

**As Arizona continues seeing increases in new HIV diagnoses, Spectrum Medical Care Center remains committed to expanding access to personalized HIV care and long-term healthcare support. With nearly 20,000 Arizonans currently living with HIV, access to trusted, community-centered healthcare remains more important than ever.**

In 2025, Spectrum Medical conducted more than 4,000 HIV tests, delivered 2,832 HIV care visits, and provided 2,797 PrEP visits through our clinic, mobile outreach efforts, Testing After Dark initiative, and community partnerships across the Valley.

These programs helped connect thousands of individuals to testing, prevention resources, and ongoing HIV care in welcoming environments designed around the needs of the communities we serve.

Spectrum Medical also expanded access to evolving HIV prevention options, including new long-acting injectable PrEP options.

With more than 10,000 clinic visits in 2025, and leading roles with Phoenix' Fast Track Cities Initiative and Aunt Rita's Foundation, Spectrum Medical continues helping shape the future of personalized HIV prevention and care across Arizona.

## Spotlight on YEZTUGO

**Launched in late 2025, YEZTUGO represents a major step forward in the fight against HIV.**

Spectrum quickly saw strong adoption of this new, 6-month injectable HIV prevention medication, with nearly 200 patients receiving care through this new offering and more than 100 individuals waiting to begin, underscoring both its promise and the urgent need for expanded access.

(Community Access to Resources, Education, and Services) programs connect individuals to care in trusted community spaces, removing barriers, reducing stigma, and creating real-time access to testing, prevention, and treatment. Through consistent presence, innovative programming, and strong partnerships, we continue to expand our reach and deepen our impact across Phoenix and beyond.



# Our Community Offerings

## Testing After Dark:

A confidential, stigma-free evening testing program that connected more than 450 individuals to HIV and STI testing, prevention, and care over the past year.

## Education Programs:

Expanding sex-positive, stigma-free education focused on HIV prevention, STI awareness, and harm reduction, reaching new audiences in recovery, re-entry, and community-based settings.

## Pride & Community Events:

High-visibility outreach across Arizona, engaging thousands through testing, education, and connection to care in spaces where community naturally gathers.

## Partnerships:

Strategic collaborations that extend Spectrum's reach into high-need communities, including heat relief efforts, safe outdoor spaces, and recovery-focused events, meeting immediate needs while connecting individuals to ongoing care.

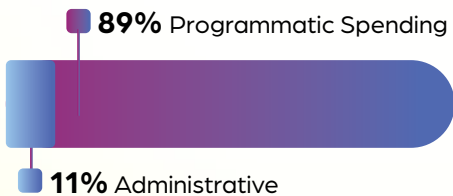
